

🖿 1. Retrospective Analysis of 2227 Restylane Filler Treatments

American Journal of Cosmetic Surgery (2025)

- Setting: Acquisition Aesthetics
- 📊 Treatments: 2,227 HA filler procedures
- M Complication rate: 0.27%
- Key Takeaways:
 - Tear troughs and lips showed slightly higher complication rates (not significant).
 - Most events were mild (bruising, asymmetry); no serious AEs were recorded.
 - Validates the safety and oversight of HA filler treatments in a supervised training setting.

🗎 2. Multilayering Technique of Injecting Dermal Fillers

American Journal of Cosmetic Surgery (2024)

- E Review Type: Scoping review of 6 studies (cadaver + clinical)
- Technique: Multi-plane filler injections tailored to facial anatomy and filler rheology
- Benefits:
 - More natural outcomes
- Improved longevity
- Lower risk of overfilling
- A Gap Identified: Lack of large-scale RCTs comparing with single-layer methods

🖹 3. Psychosocial Motivations for Aesthetic Treatments in the Post-COVID Era

Journal of Cosmetic Medicine (2024)

- ¶ Surveyed: 147 patients post-pandemic
- Top motivators: Confidence, ageing, reduced self-consciousness
- New finding: Subtle shift toward social conformity and appearance acceptance post-COVID
- Clinical relevance: Highlights need for patient-centred, psychologically sensitive consultations

4. Gender Disparity in Speaker Representation at International Aesthetic Conferences

Journal of Clinical & Aesthetic Dermatology (2024)

✓ Findings:

- 66% of speakers were male across AMWC, IMCAS, and FACE
- 26.4% of panels were entirely male
- Recontext: In a female-dominated patient population, women remain underrepresented on stage

5. The Impact of Maternity Leave on Aesthetic Clinicians & the Need for a Return-to-Work Scheme

Aesthetic Plastic Surgery (2025)

- 👽 Study design: Qualitative interviews with 8 UK-based female injectors
- Insights:
- Average leave: 2.6 months
- Key challenges: breastfeeding, client retention, psychological strain
- No formal RTW policy exists in aesthetics
- Proposed solution: Flexible, mentored RTW support and contractual protection during leave

6. What Does It Mean to Be Beautiful?

E Journal of Clinical and Aesthetic Dermatology (2025)

- A deep dive into Al-driven beauty tools (e.g., Facial Aesthetic Index, Youthfulness Index)
- Critiques the limitations of algorithmic beauty scoring
- Integrates evolutionary biology, neuroscience, and cultural theory to reframe beauty as subjective, multifactorial, and individual
- Advocates for combining clinical judgment, cultural awareness, and patient-led goals in treatment planning


